Course: ACI-ICAO Airport User Charges

Julián worked for seven years in the Economic Analysis and Policy Section of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) in Montreal, Canada. He was responsible for the ICAO Airport and Air Navigation Services Infrastructure Management Programme. Julián was a key member of the team that conducted the Conference on the Economics of Airports and Air Navigation Services (CEANS – Montreal, September 2008).

During his years in ICAO, Julián revised existing and developed new policies and guidance material on airport and air navigation services charges, economics and regulation. He also designed the joint ACI/ICAO training programme on airport user charges, and has been the lead instructor at 29 related workshops held to date.

Prior to relocating to Montreal, Julián worked 22 years at the International Air Transport Association (IATA) in Geneva, Switzerland. He headed the Statistics Unit and the Air Traffic Forecasting Programme, and spent 12 years in the User Charges Department, of which the last six as Director, User Charges. Julián led numerous charges consultations and negotiations with airports and air navigation services providers on behalf of IATA Member airlines, and participated, often as a speaker, at many international civil aviation industry conferences and meetings.
