Mohamed Iheb Hamdi is currently the Regional Officer for Aerodromes and Ground Aids (AGA) at the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Middle East Office. Mohamed is an ICAO USOAP-CMA Auditor. He started with the Civil Aviation and Airports Office (OACA), which operates seven international airports in Tunisia, as the Aerodromes, Ground Aids & Airside Operations (AGA-OPS) Manager then as the Head of the Aerodrome Certification Division. He also worked as a consultant for airport planning and design before joining ICAO.

He was an officer in the Tunisian Air Force before being seconded to the Civil Aviation industry in 2007. His main skills are in the areas of airports planning and design, safety and airside operations, and aerodromes safety management.

He has been assigned several projects related to overseeing airport safety including:

- Participation in Master Plans development and Planning and Design aerodromes based on forecasted Air Traffic Data
- Controlling Obstacles Limitation Surfaces
- Implementation of Aerodrome Certification requirements
- Participation in Safety Studies
- Implementation of the ICAO-USOAP CMA Protocol Questions (PQs) requirements in the field of AGA

Mohamed's background in engineering has kept him actively involved in aviation software design related to Obstacles Limitation Surfaces, Airside planning and Maintenance and A-CDM (Airports Collaborative Decision Making).

He has been giving courses since 2010 at the Tunisian Air Force Academy and conducting seminars/workshops on Safety and Airside Operations, Safety Management Systems and Aerodrome Planning and Design (ICAO Annex 14) to the benefit of the United Nations and the African Union.

He delivers ACI's courses in French and English. He has also delivered ACI training in Madinah, Saudi Arabia and assisted in the delivery of the ACI Airport Excellence (APEX) Safety Assessor Training Programme in Tunis, Tunisia.
