Owens has over 30 years within the airport industry working primarily in airside operations, holding numerous roles including Airport Police Officer/Fire fighter and for 14 years was the Airside Training & Auditing Manager for Dublin Airport (30m passengers). He successfully introduced the ICAO Trainair Plus programme at Dublin airport which included writing two standardised training packages approved by ICAO.

Owen has participated in over 15 ACI Airport Excellence (APEX) in Safety reviews across the globe, specialising in apron and airfield operations, airside operational training, and aerodrome wildlife and habitat management. He was Team Leader for two of these APEX safety reviews, in Uganda and Myanmar.

Owen has developed several training programmes under the ACI Authorised Training Institute (ATI) programme scripted two chapters of the ACI Handbook on Wildlife and Habitat Management (Frist edition, 2013). He has also recently reviewed and developed several training packages for ACI Global Training's online training programmes.

He has been accepted on to the ICAO Technical Co-operation Bureau and EASA's Aerodrome Operational Expert pool, specialising in Airside Operations and Wildlife Control management. He is currently participating in a review of ICAO Doc 9137 Part 3.

In recent years, Owen has concentrated fully on international projects where he has worked closely with ACI and ICAO on delivering the ACI/ICAO training programmes in Asia, Africa, Caribbean Europe, Pacific Islands & United State of America.

Under the guidance and support of ACI Global Training he has successfully completed aerodrome operational consultancy projects in the Pacific.
