Currently, he specializes as a project leader and training instructor for Airport Collaborative Decision Making (ACDM), Airport Operations Centre (APOC) or Total Airport Management (TAM) related implementation projects.

In EUROCONTROL's airport unit in Brussels he led stakeholder meetings and had a key role in defining the European Definition of Departure Manager (DMAN) and Airport Collaborative Decision Making procedures and requirements in the Airport CDM Implementation Manual. In the Netherlands, Eugène was Project Leader for the CDM Amsterdam Airport Schiphol connection into the Network Manager (NMOC) and Project Leader CDM in Dutch Air Traffic Control LVNL.

Eugène has organised, led and been invited to several workshops, exhibition and speaking engagements within the aviation sector, including the 6th FAA-Eurocontrol ATM seminar in Baltimore 2005, ACDM workshop in Sao Paolo 2016, and CANSO CDM panel 2017. He is experienced in management, business development, marketing and sales in a multicultural business environment within the transport and aviation sector.

Since his work in Eurocontrol in 2007 Eugene has also led onsite and online ACDM trainings for airports and IATA in Singapore, Beijing, Dubai, Abu Dhabi, Hong Kong, Schiphol, Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City, as well as developed online e-learnings for Manchester, London Stansted and Amsterdam Schiphol Airports.
