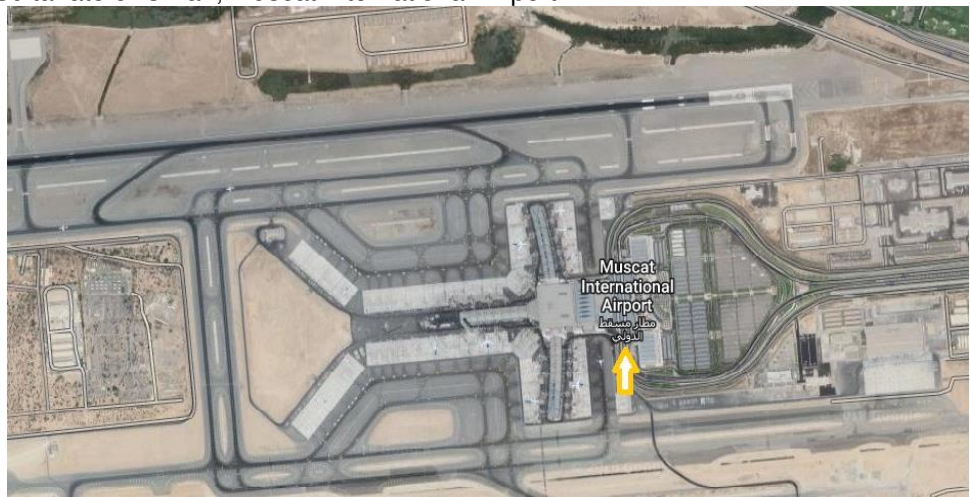

From/to the
airport:**

Public taxi and bus services are available from and to the hotel. Participants can also use the airport taxi service to drive to the hotel and also use the taxi service from the hotel to reach to the airport. Participants will be responsible for their own ground transportation to the training facility on a daily basis.

Visa and passport requirements:

Passport valid for at least **6 months after the intended date of departure is required** by all nationals traveling to Oman. Passport must have at least one blank page for entry stamp. Passengers who also require a visa must have a passport with two blank facing pages, one for the visa and one for their entry stamp.

Local currency and Exchange

Money can be exchanged at banks and bureaux de change, Proof of identity may be requested; therefore, it is advisable to carry a passport. MasterCard and Visa are preferred.

ATMs are available all over the towns and cities including shopping malls and petrol stations and accept all international debit and credit cards. Almost all hotels, shops and restaurants, and even national parks and game reserves accept credit cards.
