- Manage contractor invoicing via the City of Chicago Financial Management System.
- Randomly observe contract security staff performance to identify and correct noncompliance and performance issues related to the ORD and MDW Airport Security Programs.
- Coordinate as needed with Aviation Security staff and management to ensure consistent contract performance of the Unarmed Security Contractors for ORD and MDW Airports.
- Submit weekly/monthly contract security performance reports to executive management.
- Monitor and advise the Assistant Commissioner of Security Regulatory and Compliance and Assistant Commissioner of Security Operations (to include after hours), of daily issues pertaining to the performance of the contractor at ORD and MDW Airports.
- Attending weekly Safety and Security Staff Meetings.
- Participate in the annual Safety and Security Budget formulation process.
- Proactively conduct and document quality assurance inspections of contractor performance at ORD and MDW Airports.
- Ensures the efficient operation of all services provided by Unarmed Contract Security at both ORD and MDW Airports by effective contract monitoring and proactive problem solving.
- Performs other related duties as required.
