ICAO Workshop for airports: 19 June 2024, Montreal

Program

Objectives

This ICAO Workshop will review why ICAO was created in 1944, how it works, what its current role is, and how Airports Council International interacts daily with ICAO to shape the global Standards for civil aviation. Participants will visit ICAO's Headquarters and take part in a simulation of ICAO's decision-making. The afternoon workshop will also provide an opportunity for participants to exchange information on high-level policy developments that have global implications.

At the end of the workshop, participants will be better equipped to influence policy decisions at local level by drawing on the latest ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices and knowledge of current global developments.

How the Workshop is structured

This workshop consists of 2 independent but complementary half-day blocks. Members can choose to attend either or both blocks.

Any ACI member airport representative or World Business Partner, at any level, who is involved or interested in policy and regulatory affairs, international relations or technical / subject matter advocacy.
