

# Cybersecurity Tabletop Exercise

## Program

### Objectives

This tabletop exercise aims to assess and improve the preparedness of airports and its ecosystem to respond to a complex cyber incident that:

- Spreads rapidly across airport IT and operational technology (OT) systems.
- Disrupts critical operations that cannot be fixed with a simple rebooting.
- Has a cascading impact on the airport's reputation, legal standing, and financial health.
- Requires a coordinated response from various departments, including IT, Security, Operations, Public Relations, and vendors.

Through this exercise, participants will:

- Identify vulnerabilities in current cybersecurity protocols, particularly regarding OT systems.
- Practice implementing the organization's incident response plan in a dynamic and high-pressure scenario.
- Refine communication strategies for internal and external stakeholders during a crisis.
- Prioritize response efforts to mitigate damage to critical operations and passenger safety.

### How the Tabletop exercise is structured

This tabletop exercise consists of a group of 30 participants with 6 tables, one facilitator per table.

A scenario will be distributed to participants and members will be required to react to different injects throughout the scenario.
